

The training that satisfies N.J.A.C. 5:10-6.6(g)1, shall in all cases be the National Center for Healthy Housing's EPA approved training for the Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Program pursuant to 40 CFR Part 745, Subpart L(Renovator Initial Course) along with your submitted curriculum for the applicable New Jersey law. **Please be advised that individuals will need to be trained in both parts before they have satisfied the training required by N.J.A.C. 5:10-6.6(g)1.**

The training that satisfies N.J.A.C. 5:10-6.6(g)2 shall in all cases be the National Center for Healthy Housing's EPA approved training for the Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Program pursuant to 40 CFR Part 745, Subpart L(Dust Sampling Technician Initial Course).

Please be advised that positive identification of attendees along with any associated recordkeeping is your responsibility as the training provider. Furthermore, this Department is requesting written notification including time and place of all courses being offered.
