RE: PROVISIONAL ACCREDITATION FOR INITIAL AND REFRESHER
RENOVATOR AND DUST SAMPLING TRAINING COURSE

Dear Mr. MacRoy:

This letter is your official notification that NCHH has met the requirements under Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-070 for provisional accreditation of its Initial and Refresher Renovator and Dust Sampling Training Course. The provisional accreditation is in effect through July 27, 2011. As a provisionally accredited training provider, NCHH is required to meet all standards applicable to the Initial and Refresher Renovator and Dust Sampling Training Course as set forth in OAR 333-070-0125 through 333-070-0160.

Provisional accreditation signifies the Department has reviewed and approved the original accreditation application and the renewal application materials. Before granting full accreditation, we will conduct another on-site field audit. On-site audits must be successfully completed before full accreditation may be awarded.

Individuals seeking certification as a Renovator in the Department's Lead-Based Paint Program may use the Initial or Refresher Renovator and Dust Sampling Training Course provided by NCHH to fulfill the training requirement as long as the course maintains status as either a provisionally accredited or fully accredited training course.

Per OAR 333-070-0160(2), as an accredited training provider, your firm is required to pay DHS a fee of \$17 for each student that successfully completes any of the renovator or dust sampling technician courses as of August 1, 2010. In addition, your firm is responsible for submitting to DHS the names of those


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individuals that successfully pass any of these courses. The course date, location, and title should also be included. This information and the associated fees are due to DHS within 10 business days of the date the course is completed. Other notification requirements can be found in OAR 333-070-0135 (8) through (15).
